## ABW's Terrorism Prevention opens an e-learning portal

- The portal includes educational videos and an e-learning course on terrorism prevention, prepared on the basis of the expertise of ABW's Terrorism Prevention officers and the exchange of information with partner secret services.
- The aim of the website and the course is to raise the anti-terrorism awareness of officials and public administration officials in Poland.
- Access to the course is possible after receiving the login and password. ABW's Terrorism Prevention sends login data to offices and institutions from the target group.

The target group consists of: Ministry of Interior and Administration, Police, Border Guard, Prison Service, Office for Foreigners, Labour Office, State Fire Service, National Tax Administration, State Protection Service, Institute of National Remembrance, Government Centre for Security, Provincial Office.

## E-learning course

- O The course consists of 5 modules:
- 1. Radicalization
- 2. Recommended behaviours in the event of a terrorist threat
- 3. Rescue in hazardous conditions
- 4. Cybersecurity
- 5. Strategic communication, security of facilities, alerting and evacuation
- The training includes 7 movies and 40 animations.
- The course includes interactive elements.
- After completing the training and successfully passing the test, the User receives a Certificate - available in PDF format.
